A guide to scoring

0.No cask ale available.

- 1. Poor Beer that is anything from barely drinkable to drinkable with considerable resentment.
- 2.Average. Competently kept, drinkable pint but doesn't inspire in any way, not worth moving to another pub but you drink the beer without really noticing
- 3.Good. Good beer in good form. You may cancel plans to move to the next pub. You want to stay for another pint and may seek out the beer again.
- **4.Very Good.** Excellent beer in excellent condition.
- 5.Perfect. Probably the best you are ever likely to find. A seasoned drinker will award this score very rarely.
- +++ Use of fractions (1/4, 1/2, 3/4) for finer distinctions will only be applicable to local (not national) score recording. +++
