### Stockport Beer Week 2018

Stockport Beer Week is back again, running from 20th - 30th September, and will feature a number of events mainly concentrated in and around the Town Centre. Stockport has some great pubs and bars and many different styles of beer are available, so we want to encourage people to visit different places, try new beers and learn more about the industry. And to illustrate the point, you could become a brewer for a day at Stockport Brewing Company by supporting the raffle run by our charity partner, Stockport Cerebral Palsy Society.

The Ale Trail, supported by Robinsons, will be back and features some different pubs this year whilst the pub cellar tours are expanded to include new venues. The Remedy Bar will, again, be holding a beer festival, whilst the Calvert's Court will be showcasing Stockport beers. The fiendish Stockport Quiz returns to the Spinning Top on Wellington Road, where you can also meet the people behind Poynton Brewery and enjoy another "Woodstockport" music event featuring local bands.

The Petersgate Tap is the regional Cider Pub of the Year, so it is only appropriate that they will be running a tasting of ciders and perries, whilst they will also host the brewers from Torrside Brewery, who will be launching a new barrel aged beer. Up the Slope at the Hope, there will also be a new beer launch and brewery tours, and Daisy Turnell, marketing manager of the Head of Steam chain, will run a tasting of North East beers, where you are encouraged to bring non-beer drinkers along.

Watch out for an event at the new Light Cinema in the Redrock development and keep your eyes open for the special "Beer Week Beer" brewed for us by Richard at Thirst Class Ales. Out of the town centre, we have a guided tour of some of the pubs on the bus 384 route in Romiley and Marple.

Thanks to all our sponsors including **Stockport Council, Totally Stockport, Robinsons Brewery, Imagine FM, Stockport Express** and **Metro Taxis** as we all have one goal; to assist in the regeneration of our Town Centre.
